

**II, DANIELA****LCA 520**

[Not in Mahele Book; see "Copy" of Privy Council resolution below, which was found in Foreign Testimony, Vol. 15 p 74]:

"(Copy) Resolved, that in view of the statement of His Majesty, that it was his intention originally to have the Division of lands made to secure to Daniela Ii of Maui, **Huelo in Hamakualoa and Nakalepo in Lahaina and to the Government, Kalulu on Lanai**, but that the matter was forgotten at the time, the Minister of the Interior is authorized to correct the decision on record accordingly."

Claim 520 -- no land records recorded; following found in FT 74.15:

Ua, sworn, and being shown the survey made by Mr. Alexander, says he knows the piece of land represented [Huelo] and that it belongs to Claimant. It was given to Ii by Hoapilikane in the year 1835 as an absolute gift. Claimant has held uninterrupted possession of the place up to this time; has a house on it and always cultivated it.

Also in FT 74.15: Kaumauma, sworn, knows the place claimed by Daniela Ii. It was given him by Hoapilikane in the year 1835. He has cultivated and held uninterrupted possession of the place up to this time. It is the same place as is described in the survey.

NR 185.6 January 18, 1848, Daniela Ii claims lands in Hamakua [Maui] named Huelo and Pauwela. In Huelo, Kahaloa and Kahalii; in Pauwela the ili of Kapuna, Hoopauwahie, Waikiki. Also claims houselot at Kalanikahua [Honolulu]

NT 450.5 July 13, 1847: Paele testifies to his 27 parcels in Hamakualoa [Maui]; given him by Auhea [Kekauluohi] in 1842. Parcels in Kahaloa ili given him by Kamehameha II in 1820.

FT 73.8 Paele witness to 7 apana which had been received from Kamehameha II in 1820

LCA 4579 (RP 4495) Pauwela, Hamakualoa, Maui 6.07 ac/4 apana

601: John Ii's mother, Wanaoa Kalaikane, to Kuaena had John Papa Ii; her niece, Kalaikane, to Kaneauluwahine had two sons, Daniel Papa Ii and Kekoena, and a daughter (Ii 1959: 22).
