OBIT. from *Kuokoa*, December 20, 1873:

"At Aikupika, here in Honolulu, last Thursday [December 18], Luahine, own mother of Konia, wife of Hon. A. Paki, and grandmother of the Honorable Mrs. Pauahi Bishop, died of old age. Her weariness has been laid aside. However, her granddaughter was not present at her departure. She was between 90 and 100 years old."

OBIT. from *Ka Nupepa Nuhou* December 23, 1873

[trans. in McKinzie 1986 v. 2 p 85:]

"Saturday morning Luahine was taken by the spirits of the night at Aikupita, residence of Princess Pauahi in Honolulu. She was a descendant of the high priestly class of Paoa and Holoae. She was born six months from the battle of Kepaniwai in Iao in Maui in the year 1790, therefore, is 84 years, 5 months, and 11 days. The following is her ancestry: Holoae married Koohuki [Kaohuki] and had Pine (w) and Paliki (k) [Pailili]. From Pine comes Kalilipakalua (w) and Kekuhaulpio (k), a famous warrior of ancient time. Kailipakalua married Hao (k) and had Luahine. Luahine married Kaoleioku and had Konia; Konia married Paki and had Pauahi, who is living. Therefore, Luahine was a grandmother of Princess Pauahi. Last Sunday a wake was held at the house."
